

THE PARK, THE STOCKYARD & THE DEPOT

CHARACTER AREA 4



OVERVIEW


This character area divides into three sub-areas, all of which are characterised by strong enclosure with mature deciduous woodland. The use and design of each reflects its characteristics and location.

ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPE

- The Park – forms a shallow bowl accommodating 15 1½ and 2-storey lodges.
- The Stockyard – an enclosed space formed by woodland to be extended to convey a “tree top” character to accommodate 17 2-storey lodges.
- The Depot – character to remain relatively unchanged accommodating a multi-use games area (MUGA) and tennis courts within a dense wooded area.

BIODIVERSITY

- Highly wooded landscapes will encourage local woodland species.
- New woodland in The Park to reconnect that severed by quarrying.
- The Depot will contain woodland and enhanced water features for aquatic wildlife.
